**Loving and Leaving the Good Life** 1993-03-01 helen and scott nearing authors of living the good life and many other bestselling books lived together for 53 years until scott's death at age 100 loving and leaving the good life is helen's testimonial to their life together and to what they stood for self sufficiency generosity social justice and peace in 1932 after deciding it would be better to be poor in the country than in the city helen and scott moved from new york city to vermont here they created their legendary homestead which they described in living the good life how to live simply and sanely in a troubled world a book that has sold 250 000 copies and inspired thousands of young people to move back to the land the nearings moved to maine in 1953 where they continued their hard physical work as homesteaders and their intense intellectual work promoting social justice thirty years later as scott approached his 100th birthday he decided it was time to prepare for his death he stopped eating and six weeks later helen held him and said goodbye loving and leaving the good life is a vivid self portrait of an independent committed and gifted woman it is also an eloquent statement of what it means to grow old and to face death quietly peacefully and in control at 88 helen seems content to be nearing the end of her good life as she puts it to have partaken of and to have given love is the greatest of life's rewards there seems never an end to the loving that goes on forever and ever loving and leaving are part of living helen's death in 1995 at the age of 92 marks the end of an era yet as helen writes in her remarkable memoir when one door closes another opens as we search for a new understanding of the relationships between death and life this book provides profound insights into the question of how we age and die
