is written in response to the challenge in the bible to ask the animals with the promise that they will teach you job 12 7 8 animals are teaching engineering principles to researchers in the fairly new discipline of bio mimicry though there is some references to technological applications in this book the main focus is on what we can learn about the designer by studying the design of animals and features in the earth if you are willing to be schooled by animals you will be both informed and inspired many tribes realized in ages past that people could learn from animals because they actually did the cover photo is a case in point the iroquois tell how the squirrel taught them about maple syrup they watched as squirrels punctured the sugar maple tree with their sharp teeth then after a night s freeze the squirrels would return in the morning by then the water had evaporated leaving delicious sugar crystals to lick by being observant the iroquois learned to make maple syrup you may anticipate being able to learn something from a devoted dog or a majestic horse but some creatures will be surprising for example a tropical wasp provides a plot for a horror story their behavior seems too far fetched to be true but they really do make zombie slaves out of spiders with a designer chemical also unique is the scarab beetle which orients itself using the milky way a bug navigating by using celestial clues is a mystery the egyptians knew by asking the animals that the scarab traveled in a straight line what else may we learn by closely observing the amazing creatures on our planet

drawing on accounts from india to africa and california to tennessee and on research in neuroscience psychology and animal behavior g a bradshaw explores the minds emotions and lives of elephants wars starvation mass culls poaching and habitat loss have reduced elephant numbers from more than ten million to a few hundred thousand leaving orphans bereft of the elders who would normally mentor them as a consequence traumatized elephants have become aggressive against people other animals and even one another their behavior is comparable to that of humans who have experienced genocide other types of violence and social collapse by exploring the elephant mind and experience in the wild and in captivity bradshaw bears witness to the breakdown of ancient elephant cultures all is not lost people are working to save elephants by rescuing orphaned infants and rehabilitating adult zoo and circus elephants using the same principles psychologists apply in treating humans who have survived trauma bradshaw urges us to support these and other models of elephant recovery and to solve pressing social and environmental crises affecting all animals human or not

excerpt from whipple s animal analysis a method of teaching zoology to which is added an appendix containing directions for forming a school cabinet a few teachers of zoology favorably situated are able to get their pupils to study animals instead of books the majority although theoretically opposed to an almost exclusive use of books practically find no other way in which to secure regular and constant work from their classes for the purpose of obviating this difficulty the analysis of animals has been prepared and it is believed that if rightly used it will enable teachers satisfactorily to combine the study of books and the study of nature with most pupils the difficulty is that they do not know how to study or what to observe and if they are set at work upon specimens without a guide they turn them over aimlessly for awhile and then discouraged with this profitless proceeding beg to be allowed to return to the safe and familiar shelter of a text book when the teacher can spend his time with the class during their study hours stimulating by questions and aiding by suggestions all this may be changed but how few can spare time and strength for very much of such work the analysis of animals supplies the questions shows the pupils what characteristics to look for and affords convenient means of testing the amount and quality of work done the author offers this plan as a step in advance but as one step only and hopes that his fellow teachers who may use it will freely communicate to him objections and difficulties as well as suggestions for its improvement how to use the analysis beginning in the usual way the class learns somewhat thoroughly the characteristics of one branch e g vertebrates noticing the
